

Behaviour Agreement

Dear Parent or Guardian

At Consett Infant School we feel that your child deserves the most positive educational climate possible and would ask you to assist us in providing it for them. In order to help to develop such an environment we have drawn up a school and classroom behaviour agreement which gives each child guidance in making good decisions about consequences for appropriate and inappropriate behaviour.

Rules

- 1. Follow directions quickly.
- 2. Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself.
- 3. Keep the school tidy.
- 4. Be polite remember to say please and thank you.
- 5. Do your homework to the best of your ability.
- 6. Show respect to others.

First time a child breaks a rule

Comments:

To encourage pupils to follow our rules, we will recognise appropriate behaviour with praise, points, credit slips, stickers, stars, certificates, awards and notes home. Each classroom has 3 boards for names: A Green Board for positive behaviour, good work etc., a Yellow Board for a warning and reminder of behaviour and a Red Board for very poor behaviour.

Choice reminder

However, if a child chooses to break a rule, the following steps will be taken:

- inform the school of an emergency contact phone number.
