



Returning to school from Monday 15th June 2020

As children return to school from Monday, we will have to ensure that strict social distancing protocols are adhered to – not an easy task with children who are normally encouraged to share and work closely together.

Each child that is returning to school has been allocated to a "bubble team" that will replace classes. This will allow children to be part of a friendship group whilst maintaining safe group sizes.

This means that there will be some changes to how we do things but we will ensure that the children's emotional wellbeing comes first and we will be including lots of positive messages about hygiene, keeping ourselves safe and discussing feelings about change.

We have worked hard to prepare the school environment to ensure this is a child friendly as possible. We have used the rainbow logo in the top right hand side of this letter around school to give the children a guide on where they can go / what equipment they can use etc.

There are posters in each classroom with Catch/ Bin/ Kill / Handwashing Messages and there will be reminders and songs for children about handwashing on a regular basis in the school day.

Key points:

Drop off	We have staggered the drop off times for each bubble to
	ensure we minimise congestion and adhere to social
	distancing measures. Children will be collected from the
	main gate and then taken into school. They will sanitise
	their hands on entry into school. Coats will be taken to their
	bubble classroom.
Bubble teams	We have split each class into smaller groups (children
	will then stay in these smaller group 'bubbles' for the
	duration of the day). They will only interact with other
	children in their bubble. Each child will be issued with a
	folder to keep any work in and these will be sent home
	with the children at the end of the term.
Toilet breaks	Each bubble will have staggered toilet breaks to ensure
	we adhere to social distancing. If a child needs the
	toilet outside of these allocated toilet break times, they
	will be taken to the toilet and supervised by a member
	of staff then returned to their bubble.
Play times	Each bubble will have a staggered play time and this will be
	in an allocated zone. There will be games, resources and
	equipment out for the children to enjoy with other children
	from their bubble. Once play time is finished the children
	will return to their bubble classroom.
Lunchtimes	Each bubble will eat their lunch in their allocated classroom.
	Once their bubble team has finished lunch they will be
	taken outside to play in their allocated zone. These zones

	will be alternated daily so the children have access to the equipment / resources in each of the zones. Once play time is finished the children will return to their bubble classroom.
Pick up	We have staggered the pick up times for each bubble to ensure we minimise congestion and adhere to social distancing measures. Children will sanitise their hands before leaving the school. Children will be taken to the main gate and handed over to parents.
Uniform	Children do not need to wear their school uniform. Cool, comfortable and casual clothes should be worn. Clean clothes should be worn each day.
Water bottles	Please provide your child with a filled water bottle each day. It will be returned home every evening and should be washed every night with hot, soapy water.
Cleaning	The school will be cleaned thoroughly each day and school will close at 1pm on a Friday (except for key worker children) to allow for a deep clean of all areas.

We are aware that it has been such a terribly worrying and difficult time for families. I hope this document outlines our plans clearly without overwhelming you. As always, if you need anything at all, please do not hesitate to get in touch.
